### 2022 National Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN)



The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) for Years 3 and 5 students commences this week. FHPS students in Years 3 and 5 will participate in the NAPLAN Online assessments over a two week period. NAPLAN tests assess student knowledge and skills in writing, reading, conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy. The assessments provide parents, students and the school with information regarding student performance in both Literacy and Numeracy.

All students, except those who have been withdrawn by their parents, are required to complete the assessments. Catch up assessments will be timetabled within the two week assessment window for students who are absent on test days.

The NAPLAN reflects a student's performance at a single point in time. A student's learning journey is captured through a myriad of rich learning tasks, ongoing teacher assessment, self and peer assessment. The NAPLAN is one source of information that is used in conjunction with a range of student learning data to determine student achievement and progress.

Students are encouraged to come to school ready to do their best, but to also remember that one test cannot measure all the wonderful things that make them who they are.

## 2022 ICAS Year 2-6 Assessments

Every year FHPS provides students in Years 2-6 with the option of participating in the world-renowned International Competitions and Assessments for Schools (ICAS) in English, Mathematics and Science. ICAS is an online academic competition that is designed to assess students' higher order thinking and problem-solving skills.

Each assessment celebrates students' accomplishments by providing opportunities for recognition and development. Every student who participates will receive a printed certificate and an online results report. Top performers will be eligible for medals.

The 2022 online ICAS assessments will be held at Frankston Heights Primary School on:

The school encourages you to consider entering your child into ICAS this year. The assessments are suitable for students in Years 2-6 wishing to extend themselves academically and take up the personal challenge of competing in an international assessment.

Year 56 parents, please note that the Y56 students are on school camp during the assessment window for the ICAS Mathematics assessment. The option Janison have provided for the year 56 Mathematics assessment is for parents to register their year 56 child at an alternative sitting centre. These centres are located at different venues around Melbourne. Parents would be required to transport their child to the centre and wait until the assessment is completed. The assessments are conducted on a weekend. Y56 parents interested in pursing this option for the Mathematics assessment can contact Janison directly on 1800 931 775.

Parents register their child for one or more of the assessments online. Please note payment cannot be made through the school office.

**IMPORTANT:** Please enter your child's name accurately into the system. The details you enter are the details that will appear on your child's ICAS certificate.

Online payment closes Monday, 18 July 2022. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

# SENTRAL INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

### NOTIFYING THE SCHOOL OF A STUDENT ABSENCE

Regular attendance at school is important for students to reach their potential. Parents are required to inform the school if their child is absent from school. This process can be completed easily using the **Sentral Parent Portal** or **Sentral for** 

### Parents app.

- 1. Log on to the Sentral Parent Portal or the Parent app
- 2. Select the **absences** tab
- In the parent portal select the 'Notify of an absence' tab.

On the parent app select the **+ symbol** in the top right hand corner.

- 4. Select the name of the **child** that is absent. This will place a tick by their name.
- Using the drop down list, select the type of absence.
  e.g. illness, medical
- 6. Select the **Start Date** for the absence from the Calendar.
- 7. Select the End Date for the absence from the Calendar.
- 8. Type in a Comment explaining the reason for the absence.
- 9. Click the **Submit/Send** button.

### **RESPONDING TO NOTIFICATIONS OF UNEXPLAINED ABSENCES**

If parents do not provide a reason for their child's absence, notifications of unexplained absences will appear in the newsfeed on the app and the home feed in the portal. To provide an explanation for the absence parents need to :

- 1. Click on the absence
- 2. Enter the absence reason in the text box provided.

Parents are also advised to check unexplained student absences via the absences tab on the portal or app.

- 1. Log on to the Sentral parent portal or the parent app
- 2. Select the absences tab
- 3. Any unexplained absences will appear
- 4. Select the unexplained absence and provide an explanation.
- 5. Select submit to send reason for absence to the school.

### **UPDATING CONTACT DETAILS ON SENTRAL**

### It is imperative that the school has the current contact details of all parents.

If your address, contact number or child's emergency contact details have changed, please log on to the portal or select the cog in the top left hand corner of the parent app to update your information .

- 1. Log on to the parent portal or parent app
- 2. In the portal go to the left hand menu on the home page and select **My Details** or on the app select the cog in the top left corner and tap the **Account Details tab** to see your current details such as: family and emergency contacts and student details.
- 3. To edit a section, click the **Edit** button for the detail you want to change.
- 4. The data that can be edited appears on the right side of the screen.
- 5. Make the necessary change and click **Submit Details**.

### **MESSAGING TEACHERS FROM THE PORTAL**

In addition to the school email and Seesaw for P-2 families, messaging on Sentral through the parent portal or app can be used by parents to contact teachers directly. To message a teacher from the parent portal:
