- Select the tab titled '2024 Term 1 Parent-Teacher Meetings
- Select TIMESLOTS
- Select the **time** you would like to schedule your parent teacher meeting (available times are in black, unavailable in grey). If no times display when you select a certain date e.g., Monday March 4, it means the teacher is not available.
- A message will appear confirming your booking. Select **SAVE BOOKING**.
- Your appointment time will be displayed. Please take note of the date and time.

In the event that you **DO NOT** have access to the internet, please contact the school office and we will enter a booking time for you.
