- Click on the PARENT TEACHER INTERVIEW tab on the home page or the INTERVIEW tab on the app.
- Select the tab titled '2024 Term 1 Parent-Teacher Meetings
- Select TIMESLOTS
- Select the time you would like to schedule your parent teacher meeting (available times are in black, unavailable in grey). If no times display when you select a certain date e.g., Monday March 4, it means the teacher is not available.
- A message will appear confirming your booking. Select SAVE BOOKING.
- Your appointment time will be displayed. Please take note of the date and time.

In the event that you **DO NOT** have access to the internet, please contact the school office and we will enter a booking time for you.

Hi everyone.



FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: CAMPS, SPORTS, EXCURSIONS FUNDING (CSEF) FOR 2024

Parents with Health Care Cards/Pensions Cards can apply for CSEF.

If you applied for CSEF at Frankston Heights Primary School in 2023, you do not need to reapply in 2024 unless:

- \cdot you have another child starting school i.e. Prep
- \cdot you have moved to our school during the year
 - · you applied at another school in 2023
- · you have recently been issued a Health Care/Pension Card

Any parents who hold a Health Care Card/Pension Card and did not apply/receive CSEF through our school last year, please obtain a form from the office for CSEF funding in 2024.

FHPS 2024 TERM 1 ASSEMBLY ROSTER


ASSEMBLY AT FHPS LOOKS A LITTLE DIFFERENT THIS YEAR!
