## BOOKING YOUR PARENT-TEACHER MEETING

Follow the steps below to book your parent-teacher meeting.

- Go to the FHPS website and click on the **SENTRAL** link at the bottom of the home page
- Log onto the **FHPS Parent portal** using your user name and password.

From the **Sentral for Parents app** select the **INTERVIEWS** tab

- Click on the **PARENT TEACHER INTERVIEW** tab on the home page or the **INTERVIEW** tab on the app.
- Select the tab titled '2024 Term 1 Parent-Teacher Meetings'
- Select **TIMESLOTS**
- Select the **time** you would like to schedule your parent teacher meeting (available times are in black unavailable in grey). If no times display when you select a certain date e.g. Monday March 4, it means the teacher is not available.
- A message will appear confirming your booking. Select **SAVE BOOKING**.
- Your appointment time will be displayed. Please take note of the date and time.

In the event that you **DO NOT** have access to the internet, please contact the school office and we will enter a booking time for you.

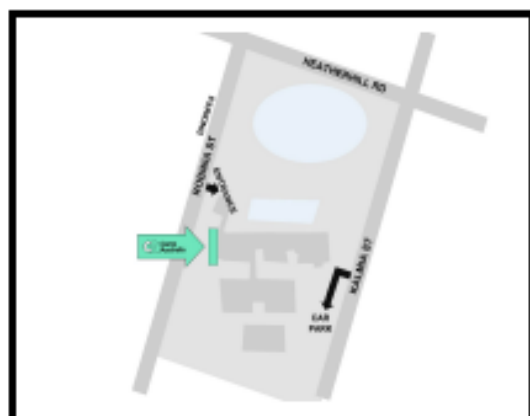
