What to wear - Students are to come dressed in a white or an old tee shirt (preferably a light colour) and shorts/pants for the colour run. Suitable running/walking shoes are required. Students can accessorise with a tutu, hat, socks etc. Students are not to wear school uniform.

Colour stations will be set up around the course. Students wanting to avoid the coloured powder can run around the stations.

The coloured powder is sourced from India, made of high-quality corn starch and is dyed with permitted food colours. It is non-toxic, biodegradable, skin safe and environmentally friendly.

2024 TERM 2 Y5&6 BODY EDUCATION WITH KELLY NASH

Sexuality education is an essential component of the Victorian Curriculum. Primary school age students are expected to participate in a comprehensive and age appropriate sexual health education program.

Frankston Heights Primary School has been fortunate to engage the expertise of Kelly Nash to deliver 'Body Education' to our Year 5 and 6 students this term. Kelly is a highly skilled, sought after Body Education educator. She creates a relaxed, inclusive and respectful learning environment to empower students with knowledge and understanding about their bodies.

A **Webex parent information session** will be held on **Tuesday April 23 at 6pm**. The information session is an opportunity for parents to find out how the school program will run and how families can assist with follow up tasks. The content that will be covered in the Year 5 and 6 program will be outlined and there will be opportunities for parents to ask questions.
