### **GROUND WORKS**



### **School Savings Bonus**

Dear parents and carers,

As shared with you previously, parents and carers of every child enrolled in a Victorian government school in 2025 will receive the one-off School Saving Bonus \$400 support.

In the coming months, the Department of Education will send you 2 email communications for each of your children enrolled in Victorian government schools. Parents must check your email address by logging on to the Sentral Parent Portal and viewing your contact details. This needs to be done immediately.

The 2 emails from the Department of Education will:

**1.** Confirm your email address between mid-October and late-November.

**2.** Provide you with your unique \$400 School Saving Bonus code by the end of November.

If you do not receive a confirmation email from the department by late-November, please check your spam or junk folders and contact our school office on 9783 4988 if needed.

### FHPS STUDENTS PARTICIPATE IN WORLD-RENOWNED ICAS ASSESSMENTS

Students from FHPS who participated in the 2024 ICAS English, Mathematics and Science Assessments are to be congratulated on their achievements. A total of thirty students from Year 2 - Year 6 participated in one or more of the assessments, with outstanding performers receiving certificates of Merit, Credit and Distinction.

Developed for students in primary and secondary school years, ICAS assesses the higher order thinking and problem-solving skills needed for success in English, Mathematics and Science. Results are compared with all Australian students in the same year level who participated in the assessments.

We are exceptionally proud of all the students who participated in one or more of the ICAS assessments.

In the English ICAS, five students were awarded a Credit, five a Merit and sixteen a Participation.

In the Mathematics ICAS, two students were awarded a Distinction, seven a Credit, five a Merit and sixteen a Participation.

In the Science ICAS, two students were awarded a Distinction, four a Credit, five a Merit and eight a Participation.

All FHPS students who participated in the ICAS will be presented with their certificates at their respective assembly this term. Students in Years 3-6 will receive their certificates at the school assembly on Friday October 18. Students in Year 2 will receive their certificates at the school assembly on Friday October 25.
