Thank you to everyone for wearing their hats! Yesterday, apart from a handful of students who left their hat at home, every student was wearing a hat in the playground!

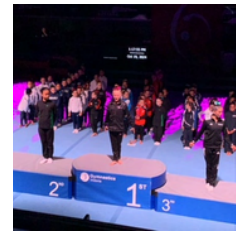
