PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE School facilities update

• The new oval irrigation system works commenced during the previous school holidays.

• Preparation for the oval resurfacing will commence directly after the school fair. The school oval will be out of action directly after the school fair. New turf will be laid early in December – we'll be looking for an army of volunteers to help roll out turf – more information to come.

• New goal post at the west end of the oval will be installed during resurfacing works.

- The cricket nets and concrete pads will be removed. We'll work with our student voice representatives in 2025 to determine the best use for this space.
- A new granitic sand path from the Heatherhill Road gate will be installed and lined with new native trees.
- Rolling facilities works plastering, painting, lino resurfacing, etc will begin during the January holidays.
 - The main entrance gardens have been tidied and replanted. A water feature will arrive this week as a centrepiece in the garden to the right-hand side of the main entrance doors.

• The indoor/outdoor play space of the Prep classrooms will be reinvented with a jungle theme during the January holidays. This space will include bamboo feature walls, log seating, synthetic turn flooring, chalk board walls, artificial trees, etc.

FAIR STALLS

There will be some EFTPOS facilities available at the Fair. Parents and children are encouraged to bring spending money to make purchases at the many wonderful stalls. Food and drink prices range from \$2-\$10. Activity prices range from \$2-\$10. Don't forget to pop into the hall to see the amazing Lego Competition.

SUPERVISION

Although the Fair begins at 1.00pm, school will be dismissed as normal at 3.30pm.

Parents/Carers are encouraged to collect children from their classrooms at 1.00pm and supervise them for the duration of the Fair. Please make sure you have returned the supervision form to your child's class teacher. The form requires parents to indicate whether their child will be:

- collected and supervised by a parent/guardian or another family at 1.00pm
- supervised by FHPS staff from 1.00pm-3.30pm
- supervised by Camp Australia OSHC from 3.30pm
- leaving at 3.30pm with an adult or walking/riding home as per usual arrangements.

Students who are not collected by an adult at 1pm will need to report to their class stall at 3:30pm where they will be dismissed by their class teacher. Parents/Carers are responsible for their child from 3:30pm and need to organise collection arrangements, e.g., collected at class stall, child meets parents at parked car, child walks or rides home or attends Camp Australia.

STUDENT LUNCH - BYO OR PURCHASE AT THE FAIR

Due to the shortened classroom times on the day of the Fair, we ask that students leave school bags at home. Students may bring their own snacks and lunch in a disposable bag or purchase lunch at the Fair. There will be a variety of food available for purchase from midday onwards.

Options include BBQ sausages, burgers, pizzas, party pies and sausage rolls. Other treats include ice cream, popcorn, slushies, ice cream spiders. Cans of soft drink, bottled water and Berri icy tubes will also be on sale to satisfy thirsty children. Food prices range from \$2-\$10. Students are encouraged to bring a wallet or small bag for their spending money.








St John CPR Lab


