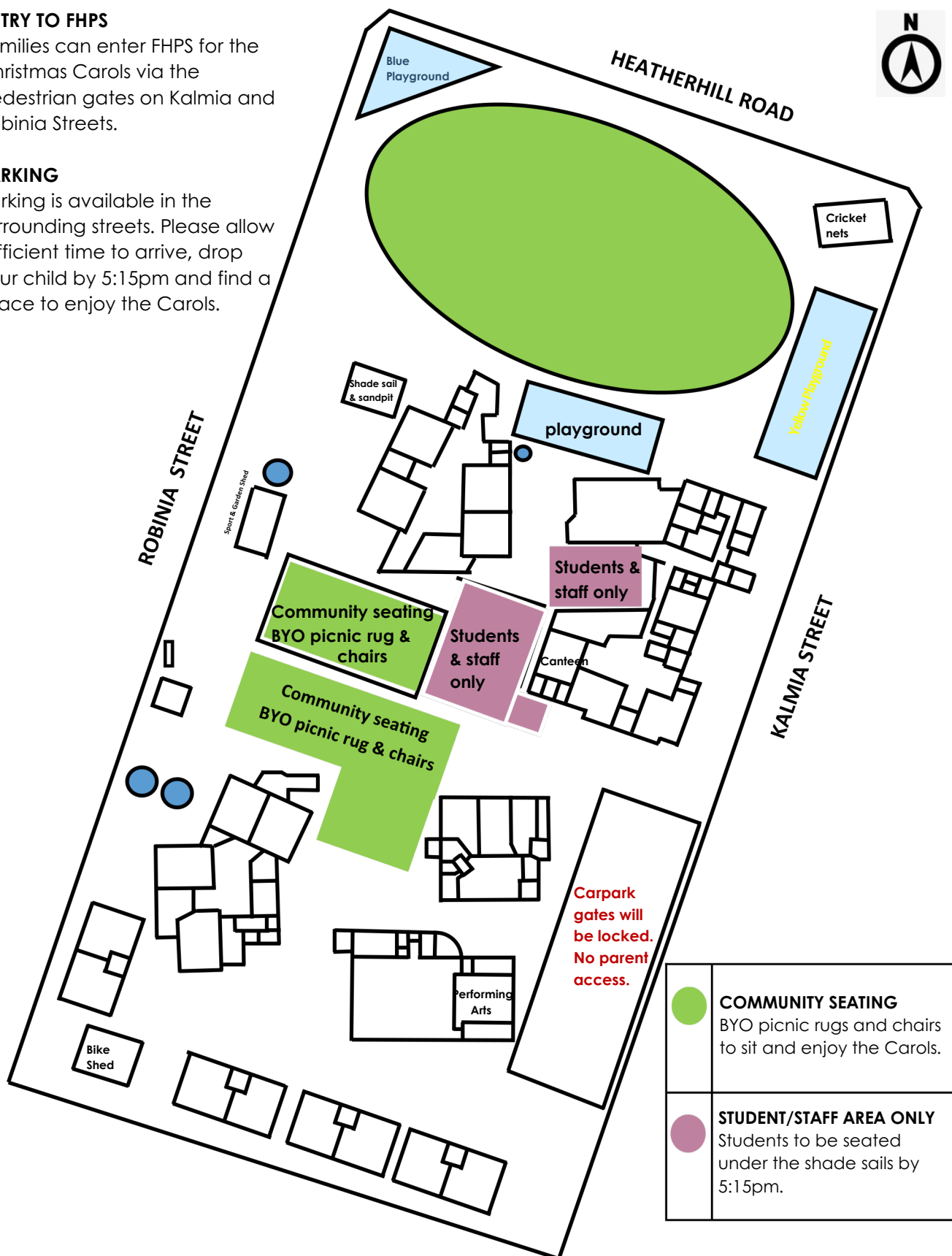
FHPS CHRISTMAS CAROLS SEATING PLAN

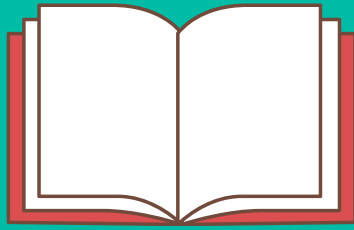
ENTRY TO FHPS

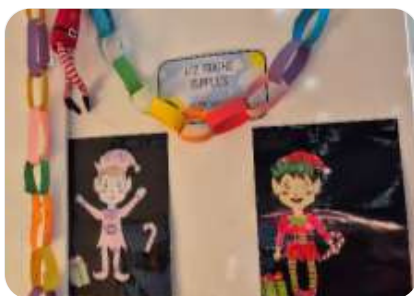
