

## ROADWORKS

#### Heatherhill Rd and Brooklyn Ave Intersection Improvement Works

Frankston Council have advised that intersection improvement works are scheduled to commence in March 2025 at the intersection of Heatherhill Road and Brooklyn Avenue.

While works are underway, Brooklyn Avenue will be closed to all through vehicle traffic with detours in place. A lane closure will also be in effect on Heatherhill Rd, with temporary traffic lights maintaining traffic flow in both directions.
