- ♦ Students are to bring a bag for the storage of their purchased gift.



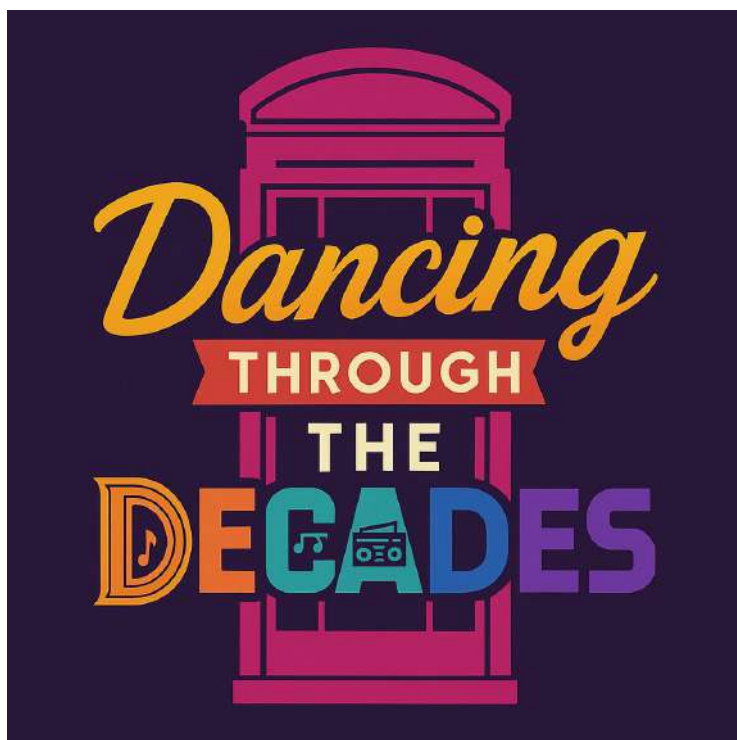
