

REHEARSAL DAY AT FRANKSTON ARTS CENTRE





- If they don't have an email add a number to yours and use it or put their name, first.surname@sck.com. It just needs to be different from yours. They won't receive any notification.
- Choose their school, add their grade, with the year number & letters. Please add your phone number in your profile, just in case there is an issue with your students order.


- The menus are ready for you to order.






Android Phone App Reset

- If you have the green spinning circle and cannot login past it, go to your phone settings.
- Scroll down to Apps.
- Tap on Apps and scroll to the Stir Crazy Kids App.
- Tap on the App, then Storage and you will see the clear cache and clear data at the bottom of the page.
- Clear the cache and delete the data. It won't delete your information in the App.
- Swipe out and you should be able to login into the App.
