- **Wednesday March 4:** Year 3–6 class teachers (1:30pm–6:00pm). Please note 6B interviews will be held on Tuesday March 3.

It is important that every family is represented at these interviews. Your insights, information and involvement help us better understand and support your child's individual needs.

HOW TO BOOK YOUR PARENT-TEACHER MEETING ON SENTRAL

Booking your interview is quick and easy. Simply follow the steps below.

OPTION 1 – VIA THE SENTRAL FOR PARENTS APP

- Open the **Sentral for Parents** app.
- Select the **INTERVIEWS** tab.

OPTION 2 – VIA THE FHPS WEBSITE

- Go to the FHPS website.
- Click the **SENTRAL** link at the bottom of the homepage.
- Log in to the Parent Portal using your username and password.
- Click **Parent Teacher Interviews**.

THEN:

- Select '**2026 Term 1 Parent-Teacher Meetings**'.
- Click **TIMESLOTS**.
- Choose your preferred time (available times appear in black; unavailable times are grey). If no times appear on a selected date, the teacher is not available that day.
- A confirmation message will appear - click **SAVE BOOKING**.
- Your appointment details will be displayed. Please make a note of the date and time.

If you do not have internet access, please contact the school office and we will assist you with making a booking.


