Learning Conversations That Matter: Student Three-Way Conferences

All families are encouraged to book a Student Three-Way Conference with their child's classroom teacher. These conferences provide an important opportunity for students, parents/carers, and teachers to come together to celebrate learning growth, acknowledge achievements, and discuss future learning goals.

Student Three-Way Conferences are a valuable part of our partnership between home and school. Guided by the classroom teacher, students take an active role in leading the conversation about their Semester 1 learning journey. To support and provide context for their mid-year report results, students share work samples, reflect on their progress and achievements, and identify areas for continued growth and improvement.

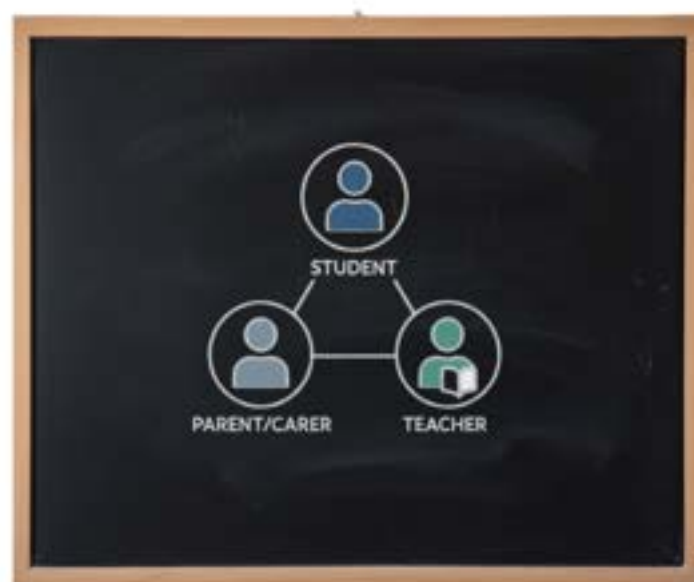
Parents and carers play an essential role in these discussions by engaging in conversations about learning, asking questions, and providing encouragement and feedback. Teachers are also available to clarify learning goals, provide additional insights into student progress, and support families in understanding their child's development both academically and socially.

These conferences are designed to:

- empower students to take ownership of their learning
- develop student voice, confidence, and agency
- support organisational and oral communication skills
- strengthen the connection between home and school
- provide meaningful opportunities to celebrate progress and set future goals together.

The partnership between students, families, and teachers is vital in supporting every child's success. We strongly encourage all students and parents/carers to attend and participate in this important learning conversation.

Please ensure you book a conference time with your child's classroom teacher. We look forward to celebrating your child's learning journey together.



BOOKING A THREE WAY CONFERENCE

Effective communication between home and school is key to every student's success. Our Three-Way Conferences provide an important platform for students to present their learning journey, discuss their progress and future goals alongside parents and teachers.

Please book your conference time through **SENTRAL**. These collaborative sessions empower students to take an active role in reflecting on and celebrating their Semester 1 achievements.

Log onto the FHPS Parent portal using your user name and password.

- Click on the **PARENT TEACHER INTERVIEW** tab on your home page or the **INTERVIEW** tab on the app.
- Select the tab titled '2026 Semester 1 Three-Way Conferences'
- Select **TIMESLOTS**
- Select the time you would like to schedule for your Three Way Conference (available timeslots are in black, unavailable in grey)
- A message will appear confirming your booking. Select **SAVE BOOKING**.
- Your appointment time will be displayed. Please take note of the date and time.
- In the event that you **DO NOT** have access to the internet, please contact the school office and we will enter a booking time for you.

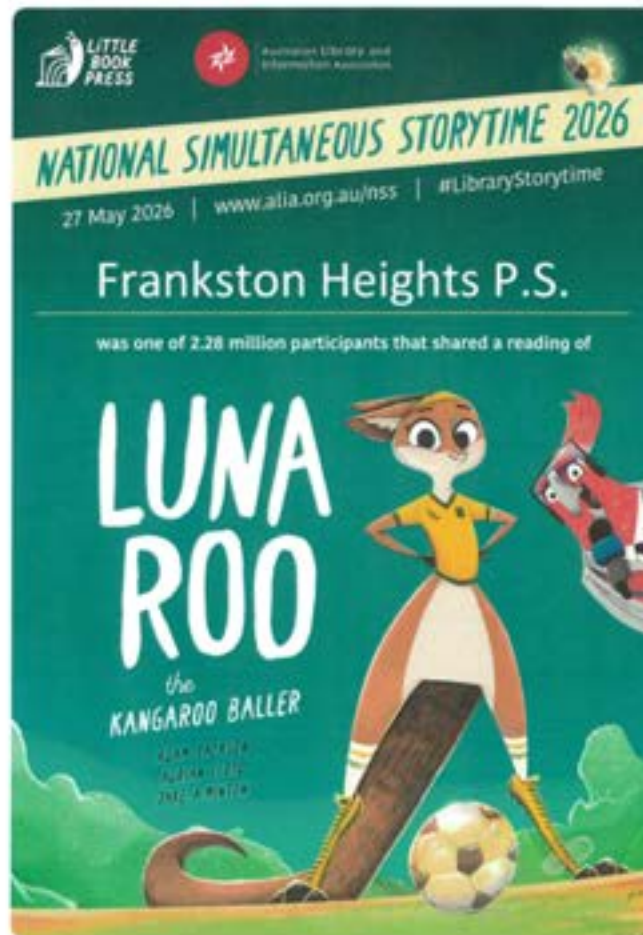




Library Update

2026 INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIONS & ASSESSMENTS FOR SCHOOLS (ICAS)

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are excited to once again offer students in Years 2-6 the opportunity to participate in the 2026 ICAS (International Competitions and Assessments for Schools).

ICAS is a globally recognised online competition in English, Mathematics and Science that challenges students to think critically and apply their problem-solving skills in new and engaging ways. It provides a wonderful opportunity for students to extend themselves beyond the classroom and experience academic challenge at an international level.

All participants receive a certificate and a detailed results report to celebrate their achievements and track their progress. High-performing students may also be awarded prestigious ICAS medals.

We encourage families to consider this opportunity for children who are motivated to challenge themselves and further develop their academic skills.

HOW TO REGISTER & MAKE AN ONLINE PAYMENT

- Go to the ICAS Shop: <https://shop.icasassessments.com/pages/parent-payment/GXF105>
- Enter student details and click **SAVE STUDENT**
- Select the ICAS test(s) you wish to purchase
- Select proceed
- Go to the checkout
- Make payment (you will receive an order confirmation email, please keep this for your records)

IMPORTANT: Please enter your child's name accurately into the system. The details you enter are the details that will appear on your child's ICAS certificate.

Online payment closes **Monday 27th July 2026.**
